**Antić: Meeting with representatives of Eko Serbia a.d. and Hellenic Petroleum, a company from Greece**

The Minister of Mining and Energy, Aleksandar Antić, had a meeting with CEO of the Hellenic - Petroleum Group, Grigoris Stergioulis, the Director of Domestic and International Sales - Mr. Robert Karahanas and CEO of Eko Serbia a.d. - Vuk Radović on the occasion of their 15 years of business operation in the Republic of Serbia.

At the meeting, it was noted that the Republic of Serbia implemented a series of successful measures in the fight against the gray economy in oil derivatives trading, which contributed to successful operation of oil companies in the market of the Republic of Serbia. The CEO of Hellenic Petroleum Group, Grigoris Stergioulis, thanked the Government of Serbia, specifying that in the fight against the gray economy, Serbia could be an example of how that should be done.
